ORDER:-

The Hon'ble Minister for Finance and Human Resources Management has made an announcement in the Budget Speech 2022-23 that,

"A pilot training programme to develop Self Help Groups into smart Self Help Groups in tune with current technological and economic needs will be launched in Madurai. The training will not only enable their development but also enable them to contribute to the betterment of the society".

- 2. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Corporation for Development of Women Limited has suggested the following suggestions for way forwarding in piloting smart Self Help Group in Madurai.
 - i. Based on the rich experience, heritage and legacy of Tamil Nadu in the digitization of Self Help Group / Panchayat Level Federation / Village Poverty Reduction Committee records from 2007-08 onwards through Pudhu Vaazhvu Project (PVP) and International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) projects, now the announcement of Smart SHG on pilot basis may be rolled out in Tamil Nadu in Madural District by providing Mobile Tablets and training to SHG members in carrying out their regular SHG activities and record maintenance like cash book, savings/ loan ledger, loan repayment ledger by digitizing the same.
 - ii. Tamil Nadu Urban Livelihood Mission (TNULM) shall pilot the Smart Self Help Group concept in the Madurai Central Assembly Constituency. The Constituency consists of 22 Wards and 20 Area Level Federations (ALFs) covering 24,215 Below Poverty Line households. So far, 1251 Self Help Groups have been formed in these 22 wards and is being federated under the 20 Area Level Federations (ALFs).
 - iii. The Smart SHG concept shall be piloted in a few Area Level Federations (ALFs) on a pilot basis as below:
 - > 5 ALFs may be chosen for the pilot for Smart Self Help Groups.

- > These 5 Area Level Federation (ALF) have 117 Self Help Groups federated under them and on an average each Area Level Federation (ALF) will cover around 20 Self Help Groups.
- ➤ A Tab costing between Rs.15,000 Rs.20,000 may be provided to each Area Level Federation (ALF) or each Self Help Group and training is to be provided to all the Self Help Group leaders i.e., Animators, Representative of the Self Help Groups federated under the concerned Area Level Federations (ALFs).
- The Area Level Federation (ALF) shall be trained on computer skills and Tally for maintenance of accounts and digitalization for Self Help Group accounts and all the financial ledgers of the Self Help Groups like the savings, loan, loan repayment, bank linkage, etc., to be maintained in digital form in the future.
- ▶ Digitization of Self Help Group records like conduct of Self Help Group meetings, record of minutes, monthly / weekly savings, e-saving passbook, e-ledger loan management, etc. can be given to all the members of the Self Help Groups under the Area Level Federation (ALF).
- > The budget for digital training to Area Level Federations (ALFs) and through them to the Self Help Groups and for provision of Tablet shall be done on a pilot basis.

Outcomes Expected from the Pilot Programme:

The project aims to transform Self Help Groups into digitally empowered Community Based Organisations (CBOs) which will form the fulcrum of women-empowered knowledge economy. The project aims at integrating Self Help Group members with digital inclusion to improve transparency and accountability of SHG operations. It also would entail real-time monitoring of SHG bank linkage and internal lending activities, creating a platform for improved credibility of SHG operations. This project would also improve the quality of interface between Self Help Group members and banks for efficient and hassle-free delivery of banking services.

Benefits of digitization of SHGs:

- Main-streaming of Self Help Group members with Digital Inclusion agenda to access a wider range of financial and other livelihood support services.
- Digitization of Self Help Group accounts will increase bankers' comfort in credit appraisal and disbursal;
- Automatic and accurate Rating of Self Help Groups will be available, online for Banks.
- Ease of transfer of social benefits and DBT through Aadhaar linked accounts and convergence with other benefit schemes of the Government.
- Real time generation of various reports relating to Self Help Group grading, financial reports, credit health, repayment track record for better and more effective decision making by monitoring agencies.
- 3. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Corporation for Development of Women Limited has, therefore, recommended the implementation of the Pilot on Smart Self Help Groups in any one of the models (3 Urban + 3 Rural) depending on the area selected for pilot, as below:-
